Please Be Careful Where You Park

Vehicles (especially trucks) parked too close to the end/entrance of the street/driveway limit other driver's view as they exit/enter the block and may result in needless accident or injury.

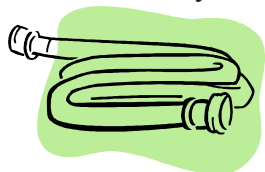

*Family swim is intended for adult members, members of their household, and up to five (5) paid guests. After 6:00pm children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by parent.

Water Tips In And Around The Home

- **Use water wisely for your lawn and garden.** Water your garden during the cool part of the day, preferably before sunrise, and avoid overwatering. To determine if your lawn needs water, step on your lawn. If the grass springs back up when you remove pressure, it doesn't need watering. If you have a sprinkler system, inspect it monthly to check for broken sprinkler heads or irrigation tubing, and position sprinkler heads to water the landscaping instead of surrounding pavement. To get specific advice on water use for your lawn or garden, sign up for a free home water audit.
- **Use shut-off nozzles on all garden hoses.** Use an automatic shut-off nozzle on your hose so that it doesn't run freely when watering or when washing the car. Whenever possible, use a broom instead of a hose when cleaning the driveway and pavement.
- **Check faucets and pipes for leaks.** A small leak from a faucet can waste more than 50 gallons of water per day. Larger leaks from irrigation systems can waste hundreds of gallons per day. If you rent, help save water by reporting leaking toilets, faucets, and irrigation systems to your landlord or property manager.
- **Don't waste water.** Turn off the tap while washing dishes or brushing teeth. Wait until full loads to run the dishwasher and clothes washer. Don't use the toilet as a trash can. Flushing trash down the toilet can waste up to seven gallons of water, cause plumbing blockages, and pollute the sewer system and eventually the San Francisco Bay.

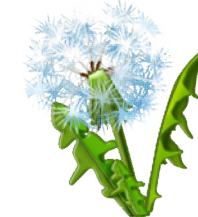


These are the dates currently planned for our summer events:
