

Private Pool for Members & Guests Only

Pool Entry Rules:

- Everyone is required to check in each time admitted and provide name and address.
- A member who is delinquent on their assessment or has current violations may not use the pool.
- All guests must be accompanied by an Association Member & pay gate fees.
- A parent/guardian must accompany children under the age of ten (10) at all times.
- Members age 13-17 may bring one (1) guest.
- If bringing more than ten (10) guests, you must fill out a "Pool Party Form", which may be obtained from the office or website. Maximum number of guests is seventy-five (75). See pool party rules below.

Guest Gate Fees

\$5/person - All guests (children under 2 free) Cash/Venmo or check only: payable to LPHOA

MEMBER RESPONSIBILITY

- Members are responsible for the behavior of their children and guests, and will be held financially responsible for any damage caused. **Members must remain at the pool with their guests at all times**.
- Members are urged to lend their support to the Lifequards who are ultimately in charge of enforcing the rules.
- Lifeguards have the authority of the Board to expel or exclude any person from the facility for violating the rules and to take any action necessary, in their judgment, to preserve and protect the health, safety, and enjoyment of the members using the facility.
 - A first offense by a youth will result in being asked to leave for the remainder of the day.
 - A second offense by a youth will result in being barred from the facility for one (1) week and parents informed.
 - The third time a youth is asked to leave they will be required to have their parents meet with the Lifeguard, manager, and two (2) Board Members. The Board will be informed about any action taken.

Pool Safety Rules

- 1. No running or rough play anywhere near the pool, deck, or cement areas.
- 2. No backward diving, backward jumping, or cartwheels off the side of the pool.
- 3. Only one (1) person at a time permitted on the diving board. No hanging from or sitting on the diving board. No cartwheels off the diving board. Divers must immediately swim to the side of the pool.
- 4. Inner tubes, rafts, and large water guns are allowed unless the Lifeguard feels they cannot see patrons in their zone and other guests are not bothered by usage of such items.
- 5. No gum, food, or drinks allowed in the pool.
- 6. Children wearing flotation devices may not be in the pool without an adult within arm's reach.
- 7. Children must know how to swim or be tall enough to stand on the bottom of the shallow end of the pool in order to swim without a parent at their side, unless approved by a Lifeguard.



- 8. Parents are responsible for their children at all times. No one over 5 years old is allowed in the Baby Pool. No pool noodles are allowed in the baby pool. All children in the Baby Pool must be accompanied by a parent at poolside. All children not "potty trained" must wear a swim diaper. If a fecal accident occurs, the member is responsible for the additional costs to clean the pool and for loss of revenue due to 24 hour closure.
- 9. Appropriate swimwear is required, no exceptions. No street clothes, T-shirts, cut-offs, thongs, etc., are allowed in pools. Rash guards or fitted t-shirts may be worn over a bathing suit for sunburn protection. Members need to make sure that their guests are aware of this rule.
- 10. Members and guests under the age of 18 may have to submit to a swimming proficiency test at the discretion of a Lifeguard.

Pool General Rules

- 1. Adult (18 or older) Swim occurs between 2:30-3:00 pm & 5:30-6:00 pm. One (1) infant non-swimmer may be with their parent if it does not interfere with the other adult swimmers.
- 2. Inappropriate displays of affection are not permitted in the pool or on the premises.
- 3. Abusive or profane language will not be permitted.
- 4. Pool or common area of the Los Paseos Association may not be used for solicitation. Los Paseos pool is intended for the private enjoyment of its Members and Guests ONLY.
- 5. Balloons are permitted in party areas only. Balloons are not allowed in the pool.
- 6. Music must not interfere with the loudspeaker, lifeguards, or other guests.
- 7. Please return tables & chairs to their original area when done using.
- 8. Only employees are allowed in the clubhouse, office, or pump house.
- 9. Place all litter in the provided trash containers and recycle when possible.
- 10. No glass is allowed in the facility.
- 11. The Los Paseos Association grounds and pool area are smoke-free facilities. This includes vapes and e-cigarettes.
- 12. Bicycles, tricycles, big wheels must be parked and locked in the bike rack and off the walkways.
- 13. No rollerblades/skates, skateboards, or pets allowed inside the pool area.
- 14. The pool is subject to closure due to inclement weather or at the discretion of the Lifeguard. The pool will be closed immediately in the case of an earthquake.

Pool Party Rules

- 1. Pool parties may be held from May thru September. There is a flat fee of \$175.00. Additional space for inflatables will have a charge of \$100.
- 2. Pool parties may be held between the hours of 12:00 pm and 6:00 pm. Party guests are not allowed to remain on the premises after the party concludes-a \$50 fine will be imposed if the party is not over or cleaned up by 6pm. Please plan accordingly. Note: on home swim meet days the pool will not be open to members until 2:00 pm.
- 3. Only members may have a pool party at the facility. If a member would like to sponsor a friend or family member's pool party, there is a fee of \$500 + \$500 deposit, but the member MUST be present for the entire party. Any member not following this rule will have their pool privileges revoked.
- 4. No more than three pool parties per day are allowed at the club. Parties must not exceed seventy-five (75) guests. Only ONE reservation area will be allowed per member.
- 5. Pool party reservations **DO NOT** include access to the clubhouse or kitchen (amenities included).
- 6. Staff is **NOT** available to help with set-up or clean-up of your party.
- 7. All trash must be placed in the dumpster in the parking lot at the end of the party or a \$50 fine will be imposed.
- 8. The member is responsible for the behavior of all guests. All Rules and Regulations must be followed.
- 9. BBQ grills are available on a first come-first serve basis to ALL pool guests.
- 10. No glass containers are allowed in the facility.
